



Young Artists Needed for Lenten and Easter Project!

For FBC Children in Grades 1–6 and Older Preschoolers!

As a new way to be part of worship during the Sundays of Lent and Easter, Dr. Guffey invites the children of Conway's First Baptist Church to help the entire church family prepare for worship by creating art that will be printed in the worship guides for the Sundays of Lent and Easter. Beginning March 1, at least one picture from every child who chooses to draw will be used in some way to help us think about Jesus and the sacrificial gift of his life at the first Easter.

Every child is invited to draw at least one picture that shows something that is special to him or her about Easter and the days that lead up to it. (You can use crayons, markers, pencils or paints.) You may want to talk with a parent or teacher about Jesus' experiences during Holy Week. You may want to draw the day we call Palm Sunday, when Jesus rode into Jerusalem. You may want to draw the Last Supper. You may want to draw how you feel about how much Jesus loves you.

Opportunities to draw will be provided on some classes during Sunday School this Sunday, February 22. As well, you can draw at home using this handout. By March 2, drawing(s) should be dropped off in the Church Office or scanned and emailed to katie@firstbaptistconway.us.
