- The apostles used every opportunity to preach the Good News, even to Temple rulers.
- Paul preached the Gospel in synagogues in many cities.
- His preaching caused listeners to invite him back.
- He held discussions in synagogues with both Jews and Greeks to convince them to accept Jesus as Messiah.
- Because of Paul's preaching in synagogues, many Jews and Gentiles became believers in Christ.
- The apostles used the Temple and synagogue to further their mission.
